SRA September Board Meeting Highlights:

The meeting was called to order by President Dave at 8:08 a.m.

Minutes: There was not a quorum at the August meeting. No minutes were kept.

Treasurer's Report: Net income for the fish fry was \$3923. Our balance as of 9/1/13 was \$17,452.99. This is due to the smaller amount of money requested from Kokanee Karnival this year and that we had no qualified applicants for the OSU scholarship.

UDRC Carl Jansen: Carl shared an invitation with us inviting club members to their annual volunteer and donor appreciation event on Sept. 21. Their major areas of interest have been conservation, stream bank and silt control, and ladder fuel reduction. New efforts are being made to restore stream flow in the upper Deschutes and improving access to the Little Deschutes and Deschutes Rivers. Their major goal is to improve access between Wickiup reservoir and Benham Falls. They have proposed that the LaPine Park and Recreation District expand their boundaries to Spring River Road so that they could maintain any new access facilities.

Fly Fishing Festival Sept. 20-21: We will have our own booth. Volunteers are needed. More information will be available in this month's newsletter.

Kokanee Karnival: Sept. 23-24. Sept. 26-27; Volunteers are welcome to help at Fall River Hatchery. Contact Gary Gehlert at (541) 480-0710.

Sunriver Boat Launch: It was agreed that Sunriver Anglers would support the concept of river access from within Sunriver.

DRC Support: Mal Murphy moved and Dave Long seconded a motion to donate \$500 to the DRC. Motion carried with one dissension.

Nominating Committee: Mal Murphy, Jack McDonnell, Phil Fischer, and Gary Gehlert agreed to serve on the committee with president Dave.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:50 a.m.

SRA Members Fishing Report:

I fished Fall River the other day (early August) and caught 20+ fish (nothing big) all on a size 18 and 20 parachute adams, it was fun to target and site see fish with my 3wt. Next, I recently fished Hosmer Lake, I was headed to the channel or back lake but never got to either one, lots of action on Damselfly nymphs, black with red wire Chironomids and soft hackles. A hatch was apparent all day, fish were clearly taking emergers but I could not figure solve the puzzle, still hooked and released several fish, yes even a few Cuts. On a sight seeing trip on the same Lake I saw more fish in back lake channels than ever before.

East Lake Outing Infomation:

The East Lake Outing is coming up next Wednesday, September 11. We will meet at the East Lake Campground (the first campground you come to) at 8:30 AM. For those who would like one a brief orientation will be held until around 9:00, then it's time to fish. Lunch will be provided, including soft drinks. Bring your own beer or wine if that is your preference.

The lake has been fishing very well this year. Callibaetis, Roxy Rainbows, Woolly Buggers (Green, Olive, Black), TSWs, damselfly nymphs, any streamer with some flash in it, should work fine. Chironomids have also been hot, in green or red preferably. If we run into a hatch Callibaetis dries, Adams, Parachute Adams, in size 14-20 depending on the size of the hatch.

If anyone is camping at East Lake we'll probably use that camp site. If not we'll set up somewhere on the beach, as there are no day use areas at any of the campgrounds at East Lake. If you do plan to camp let Mal Murphy or Jim Adams know before Tuesday if possible.
