

## Fishing Regulations

This section of the Little Deschutes River is open for angling each year from the fourth Saturday in May through October 31.

The harvest limit for trout is two fish per day; two daily limits in possession; 8-inch minimum length. Only one trout over 20" may be kept per day.

There is no limit on size or number of brook trout caught.

In addition to flies and lures, the use of bait is allowed in the Little Deschutes River.

The Little Deschutes River is currently not classified as a navigable waterway. The river banks are privately owned, including the land under the water. You may however, float through and fish from a floating device.
